Guidelines – Please read carefully before completing the following application.

- 1. Eligibility Requirements
 - A. Previous recipients of the NDMCA Academic Scholarship are not eligible.
 - B. You may only apply for one scholarship per year.
 - C. Must meet one of the following:
 - High school senior accepted at an accredited two-year or four-year college.
 - Current undergraduate student enrolled fulltime at an accredited twoyear or four-year college.
 - D. U.S. Citizen
 - E. Applicant must be sponsored by a NDMCA member.
 - F. Application must be accompanied by a 500 word (minimum) typed essay stating your accomplishments, community involvement, educational plans, and future career goals.
 - G. Application must be accompanied by proof of enrollment or acceptance letter.
